 - 1. Sufficient for spiritual birth 1 Pet. 1:23; Jas. 1:18; cf. Lk 16:31
 - 2. Sufficient for spiritual Deut. 32:47; Matt. 4:4; 2 Tim. 3:16-17; 1 Pet. 2:2; 2 Pet. 1:3-4

"The sufficiency of Scripture means that Scripture contained all the words of God He intended His people to have at each stage of redemptive-history, and that it now contains everything we need God to tell us for salvation, for trusting Him perfectly, and for obeying Him perfectly" (Grudem, 127).

- B. Affirm, practice and rely on the sovereign power of the Spirit in counseling
 - 1. The Holy Spirit does work supernaturally and at times in extraordinary ways
 - 2. Pray and expect illumination, wisdom and even power
