 - 1. Affecting us personally.
 - 2. The Church is reforming her attitude and understanding.
- B. Homosexuality is our topic vs. same-sex attraction.
 - 1. Homosexuality; given over to idolatry.
 - 2. Same-sex attraction, e.g., mature Christian, church member, leader, glorifying God.
- C. Needful to have an overall understanding.
 - 1. Knowing right and wrong: God has revealed it.¹
 - 2. Marriage is unassailable.²
 - 3. Homosexuality has a cause: sin.³

II. For family and friends

- A. Family and friends of a loved one should first remember the gospel.
 - 1. When we were weak, ungodly, sinners, and enemies, Christ died for us.⁸
 - 2. Remember this is primarily an issue with God and not you personally.
- B. Wisdom is available for this trial.
 - 1. By turning to God and His word, especially in a trial.⁹
 - 2. Making a humble plan for all trials.¹⁰
- C. Loved ones need support from a friend or pastor.
- D. All sons and daughters.
 - 1. The ultimate outcome of children is not determined by the parents.¹¹
- E. Teenagers.
 - 1. A teen homosexual is a formidable problem.
 - 2. Much positively can be done to help.
 - 3. The parents' authority over a child is to be progressively replaced with relationship.

- 4. Provocations should be investigated.
- F. Adult son or daughter.
 - 1. The homosexual community is very influential.
 - 2. Loved ones response to the individual coming out.
 - 3. Many interactions not a matter of right or wrong, but require grace and wisdom.¹²
 - 4. Be watchful for potential harm to your family.¹³
 - 5. Church discipline.¹⁴
- G. Spouse.
 - 1. In destructive cases, a spouse may have been purposefully deceptive.
 - 2. A spouse may disclose a struggle with same-sex attraction which is very different.¹⁵
- H. Friendship.
 - 1. Healthy same-sex friendships are often missing in the life of the homosexual.

- A. Homosexuality is far from unchangeable.¹⁶
- B. Worshipping and serving the Creator is our goal.¹⁷
