2) Covenant of Redemption

“The Covenant of Redemption is the agreement between the Father who gives the Son, as head and redeemer of all, the elect; and the Son voluntarily takes the place of those whom the Father has given Him.” The Father, having foreseen the fall before the creation of the world, enters into a covenant with the Son and promises to give to him all of the elect. The Son then says, I will take their (the elect’s) place.” Berkhof
