Why Counseling is Like Jazz

Considering the Variables / Moving Beyond the Script

"When faced with the uncertainty of improvisation, beginners have a tendency to want to establish structure and script as quickly as possible. This can lead them to try to guess how the other actors will respond to the utterance they are considering, and thus to already be thinking ahead to their own next turn. Not only does this lead to too much conscious planning and a delay before speaking: it also prevents the beginner from listening closely to the partner's response and responding to it."

Love Summarizes

Romans 13:8-10

Owe no one anything, except to love each other, for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law. For the commandments, "You shall not commit adultery, You shall not murder, You shall not steal, You shall not covet," and any other commandment, are summed up in this word: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." Love does no wrong to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.

Love Unifies

Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience, bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive. Be watchful, stand firm in the faith, act like men, be strong. Let all that you do be done in love.


Love is Necessary

1 *Corinthians* 13:1-3

If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. If I give away all I have, and if I deliver up my body to be burned, but have not love, I gain nothing.
